



Dates in June-June 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup>

Dates in July-July 7<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>

Communication- It is required that at least 1 parent/guardian join our Remind App system. This is the primary way we communicate with you during the summer and the way that you can communicate with us. If you haven't already, please download the Remind App, join a class, and use code wiump22 to join.

Drop Off at 9:00AM (Please arrive on time)

- ALL students (except MMO 1) will be dropped off on the playground. (see rain plan below)
- MMO 1 (6-14 mons) students will use the preschool door for drop off and a staff member will meet you at the door.
- Teachers will sign students in each day.

Pick up by 1:00 PM (Please arrive on time)- late pickups after 1PM are charged \$15 per day

- ALL students (except MMO 1) will be picked up on the playground. (see rain plan below)
- MMO 1 (6-14 mons) students will use the preschool door for drop off and a staff member will meet you at the door.
- Teachers will sign students out each day to designated adult picking up.

Rain Plan during pick up/drop off: MMO 1 & MMO 2 will use main preschool door, MMO 3 will use the side door in the rose garden (right of preschool), MMO 4 will use side door on the education wing on left side of preschool. Staff member will be at the doors to greet your child when you arrive. Those arriving after 9:15 will need to come to the main preschool door and ring the doorbell.

What to bring on the first day

Please provide a change of clothes, pair of shoes, pack of diapers and a pack of wipes to keep in your child's cubby at school during the time enrolled on the first day of MMO. We will return any unused items at the end of summer MMO. If additional items are needed, we will let you know on Remind.

What to send in each day

Send a sippy cup or water bottle each day. Snacks/lunches are to be sent each day in a paper sack or plastic bento style box. NO traditional porous lunch boxes. Please write your child's name on everything.

### No Backpacks or bags

Please do not send in backpacks or bags each day. The only thing you will bring is a cup and lunch.

### Napping

MMO 1 will be the only group to take a nap while they are here. Please let your staff member know by filling out this google doc prior to the first day. We will accommodate to the best of our ability. Link <https://tinyurl.com/2p9bu97m>

Soiled items will not be cleaned. They will be bagged and sent home that day. If you would prefer them to be disposed of, please share this with your staff member.

### Sick child/family member procedure

-Students will have temperatures taken upon arrival at school each day. If child's temperature is over 100.4 or if the child shows any signs of sickness, the child will be sent back home to remain for 48 hours. Child may return to school when they have been fever or symptom free for 48 hours. This means no medications to control symptoms for 48hrs as well.

-If a child develops a fever during the school day, they will be isolated and parents will be called for immediate pick up. Child may return to school when they have been fever or symptom free for 48 hours. This means no medications to control symptoms for 48hrs as well.

-If child or anyone in their family tests positive for Covid 19 or any other contagious disease, the Director must be notified immediately by calling 912-897-2835 and leaving a message or sending a message on the Remind app. The Director will give guidance on a re-entry plan based on currently knowledge and doctor's recommendations.
